



Versavant Subject Mapping Engine

- Transparent information sharing, across independent universes of discourse, independently maintained by different people with different cultures, missions, technologies, languages, and ontological approaches.
- Subject-centric information integration, within and across arbitrary universes of discourse. It's a bottom-up way to integrate and master-index corpora that are diversely top-down.
- Open source. Apache 2.0 license. (License is free and basically unconstrained except that if you sue, you lose your license.) [versavant.sourceforge.net](http://www.versavant.net)
- No built-in ontological features or assumptions. All semantics are user-configurable/definable. All subjects, including meta-subjects, have full privileges and services.
- Built-in debugger supports auditing.
- Runs on anything that Python runs on: Windows, Unix, Mac, etc.
